Proposal:

NOTE: "that the Annual General Meeting decides to set aside an appropriate amount – SEK 5,000,000 five million – for the carrying out a study regarding the compliance with the rule of law for bank customers who have a guardian, trustee or other types of administration (liquidators, bankruptcy trustees, etc.)"

Sometimes – perhaps often – it's about language deficiency. The principal, who is an immigrant, Afgan etc, does not understand Swedish well enough, and of course not the legal terminology. We see the problems, now in our vicinity, with Brexit. Even English is a problem I personally face. One problem that has been brought to my attention is that principals do not even receive bank statements from their respective banks. Understanding government decisions creates great frustration in the language deficiency society.

Focusing on Landskrona is reasonable – the city can be managed with its approximately 50,000 inhabitants. The proximity to Copenhagen and the Danish language can not be ignored. In any case, not those who believe in a development potential for the Öresund region. Landskrona becomes part of (a district in) Copenhagen for about 1,000,000,000 SEK. This already!

Business-wise, indeed purely business-wise, I can see the importance of private individuals also getting involved and getting closer to what is happening on the other side.

CEO of the business association Dansk Erhverv Brian Mikkelsen (formerly Minister of Erhvervs and Minister of Justice, Conservative People's Party) has in the Allting put forward a proposal to create a Danish/Swedish chamber of commerce. The project, which Brian Mikkelsen highlights, is an important step in a Landskrona perspective, to bring about an integration between the people in the entire area of the island of Ven, which is part of the city of Landskrona. A secretariat for a Danish-Swedish chamber of commerce located at Rådhusorget in Landskrona clarifies the importance of, for example, facilitating commuting. Such an establishment – in, for example, SEB's former offices – means that with it will be possible to travel quickly from Danske Bank's head office to Rådhusorget in Landskrona in about 45 minutes one way incl. two short taxi trips.

NOTE: Having said that, I propose “that the Annual General Meeting decides to give the board the task of working for the creation of a Swedish/Danish chamber of commerce and that its offices be located in central Landskrona”.
